On Thursday, she will teach how to piece and quilt My Nostalgia. On Friday, she will share techniques for organizing and using scraps at the Hill 'N Hollow guild meeting at 9:30 a.m. at the Redeemer Lutheran Church at 312 West North St. Admission to the guild meeting to see Vicky's program is \$5.
