

Many Hands Make a Fine Quilt

Hill 'N Hollow Quilters Guild's raffle quilt committee presented the 2017 fund raising raffle quilt, My Garden Wedding, at the Guild's recent monthly meeting.

This quilt was inspired by Judy Niemeyer's design entitled Flowers for My Wedding Ring. The raffle quilt, My Garden Wedding was enlarged to 100" X 112" and the wedding ring blocks were completely surrounded with a floral applique border. The machine quilting was done by Tom England.

Funds from the quilt are used to provide quilting education to members and nonmembers and to continue its Community Quilt donations to local nonprofits and governmental agencies. Since 1990, the Guild has donated 6,000 to these organizations.

The quilt will be shown at various festivals throughout the year including the Guild's Autumn in the Ozarks quilt show, to be held October 19-21 in the Educational Building at the Baxter County Fairgrounds. Look for the quilt at the upcoming Gassville in the Park on June 3.
