There's a place for every guild member to get involved. There are stand-up jobs and sit-down jobs. There are jobs with lots of visitor interaction and jobs with no visitor interaction. There are four-hour shifts and one-hour shifts. You'll get to spend lots of time with beautiful quilts! And think about how much fun you'll have with your quilting friends.

Four-hour shifts include:

- Taking in quilts and turning them back to their owners
- Assisting the judge
- Hanging the quilts and taking them down

One-hour shifts include:

- Organizing and selling Country Store merchandise
- Greeting visitors and answering their questions
- Selling raffle tickets and YLI thread

Some tasks involve odd hours, including:

- Getting the building ready for the show
- Hanging the boxers
- Monitoring bids during the boxer auction
