2020 Quilt Show Rules

Each item entered MUST have a completed entry form and will be due no later than April 23. Early entries of QUILTS will be accepted during any quilt guild meetings during March or April.

Quilts are due Thursday April 23 between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm at the Searcy County Civic Center building at 515 Zack Road in Marshall, AR. They **must** be picked up between 4 and 5 pm on the day of the show, unless other arrangements have been made. At that time you will be given your quilts, the judge's comments, and any ribbons you may have won.

Each guest exhibitor is limited to 2 items per category (no more than 14 total) and must have been completed since our last quilt show in April of 2018.

Hanging sleeves are REQUIRED on all quilts and wall hangings. The top of the sleeve must not be more than 90 inches from the bottom of the quilt. If you need instructions please contact Bonnie Landis.

If you have labeled your entry, the label must be covered and pinned in place.

Each item must have a plastic zip closing sandwich bag pinned with at least two safety pins on the back RIGHT hand corner with a card inside. Write your name on one side and the category on the other side. Place the card inside the bag with your name facing inward so it won't show. Please do not pin through the card.

All items must be clean and free of pet hair, unclipped threads, etc. After judging, each item will have a number attached to the front which viewers will use to vote on their favorite.

If you want to sell one of your entries please list it (including the sale price) on the REGISTRATION sheet and we will make a tag to be placed on the quilt after judging. *There will be a 10% administration fee if your quilt sales.*

All decisions of the judge(s) are final. If only one item is entered in a category, it will be awarded a ribbon of any value only if it is worthy of an award in the judge's opinion. While all care will be taken to safe guard all entries, we must agree to not hold the guild or the Civic Center responsible for damage or theft.

Definitions

Appliqué: Quilts in which the primary design element is appliqué.

Art Quilt: Work by quilt-maker says something about the medium, color, fabric. Quilts using traditional patterns and block designs should be entered in another category.

Clothing: Must be quilted with at least two layers. Batting is optional. Can be embellished.

Miniature Quilts: Scaled-down version of a larger quilt design with blocks no larger than 4" and entire quilt no larger than 30 inches on any one side.

Miscellaneous Quilted Items: Purses, hats, bags, placemats, mug rugs, 3-D items, tree skirts, Christmas socks, etc so long as it has 3 layers and is quilted. Can be embellished.

Mixed Technique: A combination of at least two or more techniques (i.e. piecing and appliqué etc) where one technique makes up 25% or more of the quilt.

Original Design: Created directly by the quilt-maker. Does not include drafting your own version of a traditional block or taking someone else's design and changing the color or rearranging the blocks to form a different pattern.

Youth Quilt: The quilt-maker must be 17 years of age or younger.
