### 2023 Hill 'N Hollow Quilters Guild Show

Dear Quilt Show Registrant,

Thank you for entering the Hill 'N Hollow "Autumn in the Ozarks" Quilt Show 2023. Your entries will make the show more enjoyable for everyone and we hope you will find the experience interesting, educational and fun!

Your Hill 'N Hollow Quilt Show Entry Confirmation Form(s) is/are enclosed with this letter. Please read the following instructions so that the process of turning in and reclaiming your entries will go smoothly.

#### TURN-IN PROCESS:

Remove the pink copy of the three part-form. Put it in a zip-top bag and safety-pin it to the back of your quilt, with the side that does NOT show your name, facing up. Pin it securely to the lower right corner as you are facing the back of your quilt.

Deliver your entries to the Baxter County Fairgrounds, located at 1507 Fairgrounds Drive, in Mountain Home, Arkansas on **October 11, 2023**, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. If you cannot deliver your entries at that time, please have a friend deliver them for you. Be sure to bring with you the yellow and white copies of the Quilt Show Confirmation Form; the yellow copy will be returned to you at Check-In. Make sure you get a yellow copy for every entry you turn in. Keep it safe, because we will not return an entry to anyone who does not have the yellow Confirmation Form.

Remember that all quilts must have a hanging sleeve attached to the back. If a quilt does not have a sleeve, it cannot be accepted. See Rules for additional details.

Make sure your entries are clean and free of pet hair or loose threads. Also, it is imperative that all entries are free of fragrance. Due to allergies, NO fragrance is allowed — good or bad!

DO NOT bring quilts in opaque trash bags. This is to ensure that no one mistakes a quilt for trash!

The Turn-In stations at the fairgrounds will be marked with the letters of the alphabet. A greeter will give you a number. When your number is called, take your entries to the station marked with the letter of your FIRST name. Someone will take a quick look at your entries to check for cleanliness and to ensure the pink slip is properly displayed. Your yellow Confirmation Form will be returned to you at that time.

Please be patient with volunteers accepting entries. We all want to be sure that entries stay safe and the entire quilt show process is fun for all.
