Visitors will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite quilt. The drawing for First, Second and Third place will be at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday Oct 14th.

There will be shopping opportunities galore. Not only will some of the quilts displayed be for sale, but you will find sewing related items in the Guild's Fiber Arts Boutique. The vendor mall will include fabrics, sewing notions, kits, patterns, and books. Also included will be Tote bags and other handmade fabric items, along with beach bags, barn quilts, magnets, and coasters. There will be sewing machines, embroidery machines, and quilting machines and their supplies.
